Logging into your School Chromebook away from School

- 1) Open Chromebook to turn on.
- 2) You will be presented with a screen asking you to connect to a wireless network. This is your wireless network at home.



- 3) Choose your home wireless network (You may be asked to provide a password that has been assigned to your home wifi network).
- 4) The Chromebook login screen will come up.




5) Enter your plymouthschools.us Google Apps account username and password.

## Example:

Email: smithj17@plymouthschools.us

**Password**: Enter your plymouthschools.us password (Should be the same as your normal school computer password)

- 6) After logging in at home, you <u>sometimes</u> have to reconnect to your wireless network. (You may see an unable to connect to internet message in your Chrome browser). If you do see an unable to connect to internet message, then reconnect to your wifi as follows:
- a) Click on the lower right wireless icon (# 1).
- b) Click the network line (# 2) to choose your home wifi network. It should connect automatically.



7) You may NOT need to do this step, but, in case you see the below screen, please follow the below instructions. If you do not ever see this screen, that is normal.

Once you have connected to the internet, you may first have to enter your normal school computer username and password at this screen:



Enter your normal school computer username and password (not your entire plymouthschools.us email address)

## **EXAMPLE:**

**Username**: smithj17

**Password:** your normal school computer password-should be the same as your Google Apps

password.

## STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

## As a learner I will:

- 1. Never leave my Chromebook unattended.
- 2. Make sure the Chromebook is not subject to careless or intentional damage (e.g., as a result of horseplay)
- 3. Ensure that, when the Chromebook is being transported, it is as secure as possible. Chromebook

**MUST** be carried in its protective case.

- 4. Ensure that my Chromebook is charged every evening and ready for use the next day (i.e., plugging it in for charging overnight).
- 5. Store my Chromebook in a safe place, such as the student's locker, when not in use (e.g., lunch, PE, etc.). The Chromebook should be in its case and no items will be stacked on top of it.
- 6. Use my Chromebook for the task assigned by my teacher at all times. Chromebooks will **ONLY** be used for educational purposes.
- 7. Print only after teacher gives permission.
- 8. Not decorate the Chromebook in any way, including the use of stickers or decals, and not allow it to be subject to graffiti/defacing.
- 9. Not install or download software that is not approved by administration or teachers.
